Glen Canyon Dam is a concrete arch-gravity dam located on the Colorado River. The Dam is 710 feet high and constructed in 1956. The Dam is what creates Lake Powell. In addition to the Dam is also the Glen Canyon Bridge, created to facilitate the transport of supplies to the Dam.
