# THE GRAND CANYON RAILWAY



A historic heritage railroad that carries its passengers between Williams, AZ and the South Rim of the Grand Canyon National Park.

The railroad is 64 miles long and was completed in 1901. During the Christmas season, the Railway has its own Polar Express Train Ride that last approximately 90 minutes.
