DRAINAGE AREA 4,770 SQ. MILES











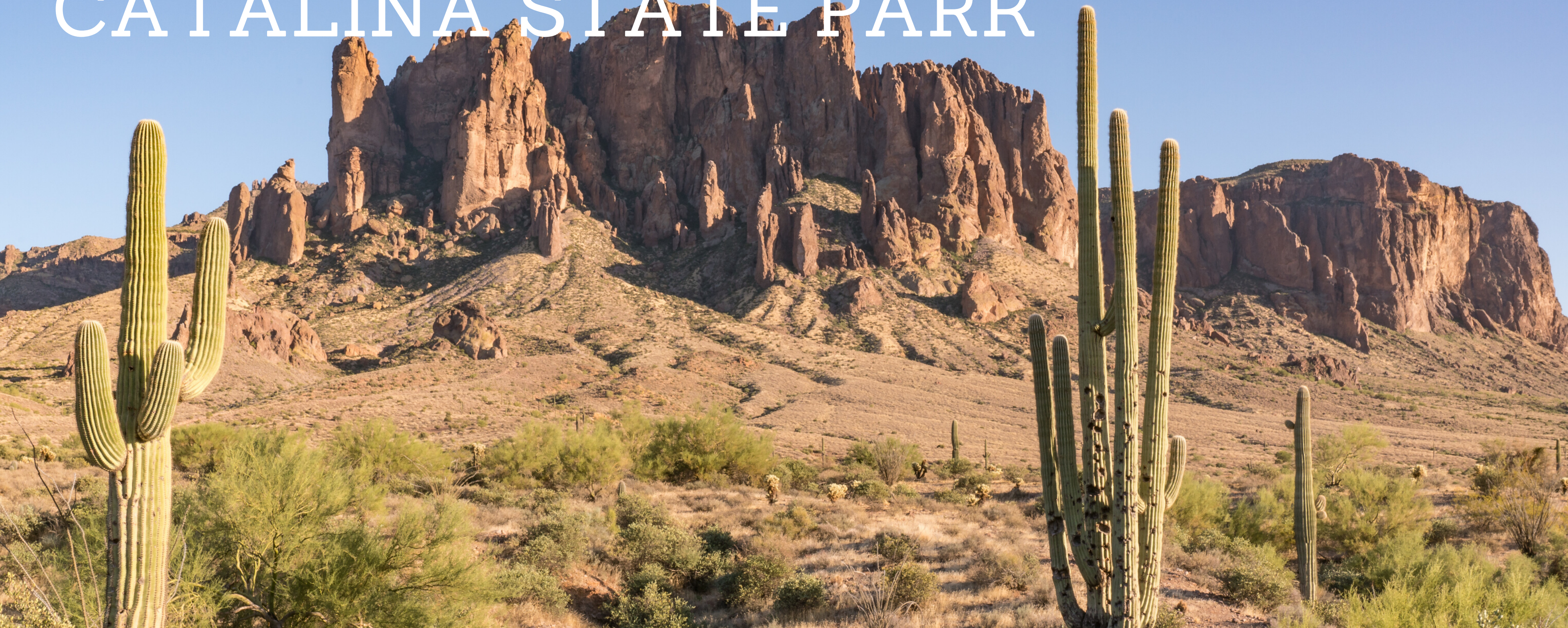
